In the Pacific Northwest of the United States lives the [Southern Resident Community of Orcas](#), an endangered population of Orcas, sometimes known as "Killer Whales".

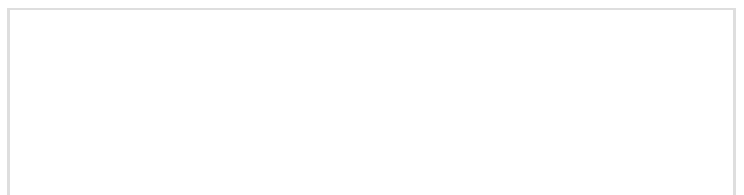
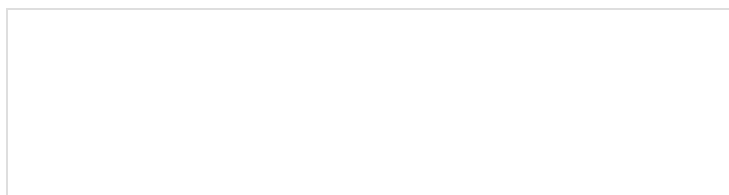

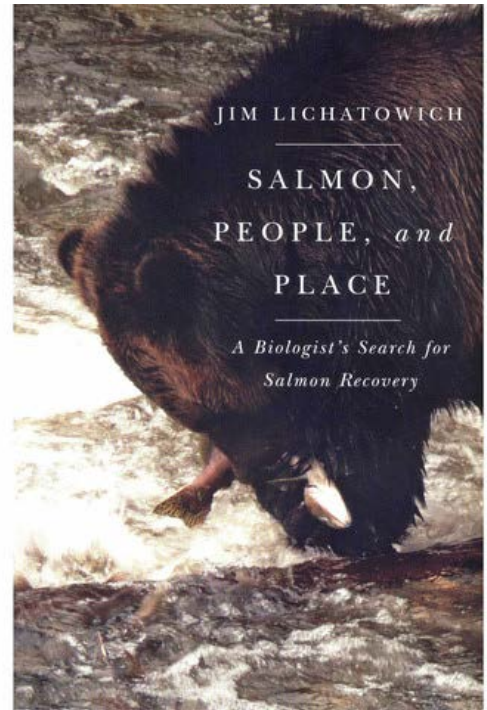
